FINAL PLAN OF ALLOCATION AND DISTRIBUTION ORDER

On September 19, 2019, Class Representative filed its Motion for Approval of Final Plan of Allocation and Distribution Order. Having held a Final Fairness Hearing in this litigation on July 12, 2019, in which the Court fulfilled its duties to consider objections and independently evaluate the fairness, reasonableness, and adequacy of the Settlement, and having thereafter finally approved the Settlement, and having thereafter entered the Initial Plan of Allocation Order to instruct the Parties and the Settlement Administrator on the manner in which the Net Settlement Fund shall be allocated and distributed to Class Members, the Court now enters this Final Plan of Allocation and Distribution Order.¹ Accordingly, the Court hereby orders that the Parties and the Settlement Administrator are to promptly carry out the terms of this Order for distribution of the Net Settlement Fund in

accordance with the Settlement Agreement and the Final Plan of Allocation submitted as Exhibit 1 to Class Representative's Motion.

1. The Court finds that the Parties have acted with reasonable diligence and in good faith to conform to the Settlement agreement and the Plan of Allocation and Distribution Order.

2. The court has reviewed Class Representative's Motion for Approval of Final Plan of Allocation and Distribution Order and finds that the proposed Final Plan of Allocation and Distribution Order complies with the Settlement Agreement and Plan of Allocation and Distribution Order.

3. The Net Settlement Fund shall be distributed to Class Members according to Class Representative's Motion and the terms of the Settlement Agreement.
